OBJECTIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS COURSE IS TO PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH MANY AND VARIED STRATEGIES WITH WHICH TO TACKLE THE **EVIDENCE-BASED READING** PORTION OF THE PSAT AND SAT TO EMPOWER STUDENTS TO **INCREASE THEIR SCORES ON THESE** TESTS. STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO DETERMINE WHICH OF THESE STRATEGIES WORKS BEST FOR HIM/HERSELF AS INDIVIDUALS.

Please also download and set up this free app on your phone. It will provide you with an SAT practice question per day. Practice is literally the BEST way to improve your SAT Reading/Writing score.

GRADING

Because SAT is designed to be graded as a percentile, not a percentage, grading in the class is challenging. MMS only allows me to put in percentage grades. Through analysis, I have arrived at what I believe is the best and fairest grading system I can.

You will have weekly homework on Khan Academy. It is simply to watch the assigned videos and do the practice questions associated with each. This homework will be worth 50 points each week.

In addition, we will have a quiz after each section of the reading selection categories: science, literature, historical documents, and social sciences. These quizzes will be actual reading selections from past SATs and so will be challenging. These will only be worth 9-11 points depending on how many questions it has.

Therefore, if you consistently do your homework completely and on time, there is no reason you cannot get an A, even if you struggle on the quizzes.

**Please note that there are only 3 ways to fail (GET AN F) this course - although I reserve the right to add to this list as needed:

- Failure to do the work assigned or preventing others from being able to do so by any means, including through disruptive behavior
