In order to create classroom environment that is POSITIVE, HELPFUL, and CONSTRUCTIVE for each student:

Each WEEK, EACH STUDENT will receive a CLASS PARTICIPATION grade worth 3 points per day.

To receive full credit, the student needs to follow *all* of the following guidelines:

- Come to class prepared to learn. When you enter the classroom, get your books out, settle down, and start to work on the warm up problem listed on the white board.
- Do not talk or make noises while the teacher is talking. Realize that when you talk or make noises that disrupt the class, you are taking away the opportunity for your fellow students to learn and understand the concepts presented.
- LISTEN, TRULY LISTEN to what is being taught, and focus on the concepts presented.
- LOOK at the teacher when she is talking and instructing to you and ACTIVELY TAKE NOTES.
- Be a participant in the class lectures. If you have a question on the material presented, raise your hand and ask your question. Do not yell out your question or disrupt the teacher while she is talking.
- Be respectful to the teacher, the other students in the class, and the classroom, DO NOT CHEW GUM.
