2019-20 SCHOLARSHIP OFFERINGS PROVIDED THROUGH NOTRE DAME HIGH SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT OFFICE

Internships/Shadow Programs

Buessing Business Scholarship/Internship

- Junior students who have a desire to pursue a career in business and/or government
- Personal Data Form to be completed and signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 2.5
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at Notre Dame
- Summer internship (30 hours per week) required (paid internship) for four to six weeks
- Knowledge in Microsoft Window Suite
- Applicant must submit a one-page essay on "How small business is important to the local economy?"
- **For 2019-2020 award:** Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded at the completion of the internship
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019

St. Luke's Shadowing Program with Scholarships

- Rising seniors eligible to apply
- Personal Data Form to be completed, signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at Notre Dame
- Student should have an interest to pursue a career in healthcare, administration or business fields
- Student must complete a summer shadowing program (unpaid) of 50 hours
- Internship hours are arranged through hospital contact and scholarship is not applied to tuition account until hours are completed and evaluation is returned
- Applicant must submit two recommendations from NDHS faculty or staff
- Applicant must submit a typed, one-page essay on the following subject: "How quality healthcare affects all aspects of the community it serves."
- **For 2019-20 award:** Two (2) \$2,500 scholarships
- **Deadline:** March 30, 2019

Memorial Scholarships

Christopher Meddaugh Memorial Scholarship – Underclassman Award

- Student must be entering grades 10, 11 or 12 for the fall semester
- Personal Data form completed signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at Notre Dame
- List of all co-curricular activities as well as honors/awards/recognitions
- One-page handwritten essay on the following subject: *“When you graduate, how do you want to be remembered by your teachers and classmates?”*
- **For 2019-20 award:** Two (2) awards in the amount of \$1,000 each
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019

John Reichl Memorial Scholarship

- Students entering grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 are eligible
- Personal Data form completed signed by the Principal
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at Notre Dame
- List of co-curricular activities, employment (if applicable), leadership roles, honors/awards/recognitions
- Consideration will be given to character of the student, student as role model, variety of activities, school pride and teamwork
- FACTS application necessary as financial need will be considered
- One page, typed essay on the following theme: *“My time at ND will help guide my life, both personally and professionally because.....”*
- **For 2019-20 award:** One (1) award of \$1,500
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019

O’Brien Family Memorial Scholarship

- Student must be entering grades 10, 11 or 12 for the fall semester
- Personal Data form completed signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 2.50
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at Notre Dame
- List of all co-curricular activities as well as honors/awards/recognitions
- List of all community activities involved with as well as any employment
- One-page essay on the following subject on one of the following two subjects:
 - Choice 1: *“Living in the moment is important because....”*
 - Choice 2: *“Describe why the arts are important to students today.”*
- **For 2019-20 award:** Two (2) \$250 scholarships will be awarded and applied to current year tuition account. One of the two scholarships will be awarded to a student within the Aquinas program at Notre Dame. The remaining award will be open to any student meeting the criteria and has an interest in the area of art and/or communications.
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019

- Student must be entering grades 10, 11 or 12 for the fall semester
- Personal Data form completed, signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 2.50
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at Notre Dame
- List of all co-curricular activities as well as honors/awards/recognitions
- List of all community activities involved with as well as any employment
- One-page essay on the following subject: “Describe one instance where you served someone and how it impacted you personally
- **For 2019-20 award:** One (1) \$500 scholarship will be awarded and applied to current year tuition account
- **DEADLINE:** May 31, 2019

Scholarship to be awarded at the 2019 Veteran’s Day celebration at Notre Dame High School

Jeff Dailey Memorial Scholarship

- Students entering grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 are eligible
- Personal Data form completed signed by the Principal
- Student must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at Notre Dame
- Student must submit two (2) letters of recommendations from a teacher, coach, moderator, or employer describing how the applicant is a compassionate leader and shows concern for others.
- **For 2019-20 award:** Eight (8) \$1,000 awards to students entering grades 9-12
- **DEADLINE:** May 15, 2019 (award presented in December 2019)

Scholarships to be awarded at the 2019 Jeff Dailey Memorial Tip-off Basketball Tournament.

Endowment & Other Scholarships

Bishop Thompson Writer’s Scholarship

- Incoming freshman only are eligible for this award
- Personal Data form completed and signed by student, parent and current Principal
- An essay of no more than 400 words explaining why you chose Notre Dame for your high school education
- **For 2019-20 award:** Four (4) \$250 scholarships
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019

Tuskes Family Scholarship Fund – Incoming Freshman from St. Jane’s, Our Lady of Perpetual Help & Holy Family Partner School Award

- Students entering grades 9 from St. Jane Frances de Chantal School, Our Lady of Perpetual Help School and Holy Family School (one scholarship awarded per school)
- Personal Data form completed and signed by student, parent and current Principal
- Satisfactory academic and discipline record while in elementary school as evidenced by a letter from the Principal
- Proof of registration at Notre Dame High School
- Student must be approved by the NDHS Financial Aid committee to receive financial aid based on FACTS application and NDHS criteria
- **For 2019-20 award:** One (1) \$1,000 scholarship per elementary partner school, credited to student’s tuition account at Notre Dame HS
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019
**This scholarship is a four-year renewable award. The following criteria must be met to receive subsequent year awards:
- Maintain satisfactory academic record (GPA of 2.0 or higher)
- Maintain satisfactory discipline record
- Remain a student at Notre Dame HS
- Continue to apply for and receive financial assistance through a FACTS application and finance committee award at Notre Dame High School

Tuskes Family Scholarship Award – Returning Notre Dame Student

- Students in grades 9, 10 and 11 are eligible to apply for this one-year award
- Personal Data Form completed and signed by the Principal
- Proof of re-enrollment at Notre Dame HS for upcoming fall semester
- Student GPA of 2.0 or higher while at NDHS
- Student has a satisfactory discipline record
- List of co-curricular activities while at Notre Dame, including activities inside and outside of school and employment
- Student must provide two letters of recommendation from a teacher, coach, moderator or employer
- Student must have applied for and been awarded financial assistance through a FACTS application at Notre Dame High School
- Student submits one essay (typed, double spaced, one page) titled: “Receiving an ND education is important to me and my family because....?”
- **2019-20 Award:** Minimum of one (1) \$1,000 scholarship payable to the student’s NDHS tuition account
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019

Tony Koury/Our Lady of Lebanon Church Award

- Students in grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 are eligible
- Student must be an active member of Our Lady of Lebanon Church
- Personal Data Form completed
- Award is dependent on number of applicants and available fund from the church donation each year
- **DEADLINE:** May 1, 2018

GRADUATING SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Red White & Blue Club's Military Scholarship for High School Seniors

- Current ND Senior Students eligible only
- Applicant must have a parent, step-parent, grandparent or sibling who is serving or has served in the US Military
- Applicant must have a 2.5 GPA or better
- Applicant must be enrolling in a 2- or 4-year college, university, or trade school
- **2019 Award:** One (1) \$1,000 scholarship awarded
- **DEADLINE:** March 11, 2019
Application available on Naviance or in the guidance office.

Christopher Meddaugh Memorial Scholarship – Senior Award

- Student must be a current ND senior enrolling in a college or university for Fall 2019
- Student's intended major in college must be in either chemistry, physics or biology
- Personal Data form completed
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- List of all co-curricular activities as well as honors/awards/recognitions
- One-page handwritten essay on the following subject: *"Because of my Notre Dame education and background, ten years from now I will"*
- **For 2019-20 award:** Two (2) awards in the amount of \$1,000 each
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019

Tuskes Family Scholarship Fund – Graduating Senior Award

- Current Notre Dame senior students, who have been accepted into a two- or four-year post-secondary institution are eligible to apply
- Personal Data form required signed by the Principal
- Student has achieved a 2.0 GPA while at NDHS
- Student has a satisfactory disciplinary record while at NDHS
- List of all co-curricular activities while at NDHS, including activities inside and outside of school and employment
- Student must provide two letters of recommendation
- **For 2019-20 award:** One (1) \$1,500 award credited to the higher education institution on behalf of the student
- **DEADLINE:** April 15, 2019

This scholarship is a four-year renewable award. For subsequent years, Student will provide the following:

- Maintain a satisfactory academic record (GPA of 2.0 or higher)
- Proof of re-enrollment

“Timothy Grube Memorial Wrestling Scholarship”

- Student must be a senior wrestler at Notre Dame High School during the 2019-20 academic year
- Personal Data form completed and signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 2.00
- List of all co-curricular activities as well as honors/awards/recognitions
- List of all community activities involved with as well as any employment
- Student must be attending a 2- or 4-year college, university or trade school after graduation from ND
- One-page essay on the following subject: “What wrestling has taught me?”
- **For 2019-20 award:** One (1) \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior wrestler at the completion of his senior year. Award will be announced during the final home wrestling match, recognized along with other graduation scholarships and payable along with graduation scholarships. Student must provide proof of enrollment in a post-high school institution prior to award payment.
- **DEADLINE:** November 1, 2019
