



RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN

Overview of Health and Safety Guidelines

Notre Dame High School looks forward to welcoming students back to school for face-to-face instruction beginning the week of August 31st. We are committed to the guidelines below for a safe and healthy return to learning.



CLEANING & SANITATION

NDHS will follow CDC guidelines for cleaning and disinfecting our school. ND will clean and disinfect frequently touched areas, such as handles, sinks, and railings. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be available in classrooms and offices. Daily cleaning will occur along with a deep cleaning every Wednesday.



SCHOOL VISITORS

Nonessential visitors, volunteers, and activities which involve other groups will be restricted.



LUNCH

Maschio's will provide "grab 'n go" lunches for purchase. Third period will be extended and students will eat in classrooms and/or outside, when possible. Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes will be provided.



HEALTH SCREENING

Students and Staff should not come into school if showing signs of illness. Both are encouraged to stay home if feeling ill. Students and staff will go to nurse immediately if feeling symptomatic and will be quarantined.



TRANSPORTATION

NDHS will partner with our local school districts and private bus company to ensure appropriate distancing and sanitization on all buses.



SCHOOL WORK

Students are returning to a blended model of hybrid learning which utilizes both in person and virtual classes. Students will be in the building 2 days a week and participating in live streamed classes, in real time, the other 3.

Wednesday fully virtual
Thursday & Friday H-Z



PERSONAL HYGIENE ROUTINES

All faculty, staff, and administration will be trained in healthy hygiene practices which will be universally applied at ND. Washing hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds, especially after bathroom use; before/after eating; after blowing nose, coughing, or sneezing.



SOCIAL DISTANCE & MASKS

Face coverings are required when entering and traveling throughout the building. There will be opportunities for students to remove masks ONLY when responsible social distancing is possible.
