Therefore Palmeri buses will follow the following districts:

NJ Bus - Phillipsburg School District St. Phillips & Janes School Warren Hills Regional School

If any one of these schools are delayed, our bus will be delayed. If any one of these schools are closed, our bus will not be transporting students to your school that day.

Allentown Bus - Allentown School District

If the Allentown School District is delayed, our bus will be delayed. If the Allentown School District is closed, our bus will not be transporting students to your school that day.

Southern Bus - Palisades School District

Quakertown School District

If any one of these school districts delay, our bus will be delayed, If any one of these districts are closed, our bus will not be transporting students to your school that day.

Pocono Bus - Stroudsburg School District
Pleasant Valley School District

If any one of these school districts delay, our bus will be delayed, If any one of these districts close, our bus will not be transporting students to your school that day.
