

Homecoming Information

For Parents and Students

When: October 7th

Where: ND Gymnasium

Time: Doors open at 7:00 pm and close at 7:30 pm (except for the homecoming court, all students must be inside the dance no later than 7:30 pm).

Cost: 5 dollars per person

Identification: All students (whether a guest or current ND student) **MUST** provide their school ID to enter the dance.

Guests: All guest **MUST** complete an official ND Guest form. Guests must be in at least 9th grade and cannot be older than 20 years of age.

Dance Departure: No one is permitted to leave the dance prior to 9:30 pm **UNLESS** an administration speaks directly to a parent.

Attire: This is a reminder to all attending the dance that ND Homecoming is considered a semi-formal dance. What that means is that every student is expected to “dress up” for the occasion.

Ladies: PLEASE remember that we are a Catholic school. Tight, clingy, extremely short cocktail dresses have no place at a Catholic high school dance. Please be smart in your choice of dress.

Gentlemen: Please remember that this is a semi-formal dance. This means a shirt and dress pants (No jeans allowed)

Additional Information:

- Students are not permitted to go to their lockers during the dance. With over 300 individuals attending the dance it is a matter of security that all students remain in the dance.
- Students are not permitted to go to the café to get snacks.
- There will be a Bethlehem Township officer at the dance.

The administration reserves the right to remove any student from the dance who does not adhere to the rules of the school (this will include vaping on school property)
