SCHOOL PROFILE 2023-2024 School Code: 391133

Notre Dame High School is a four-year co-educational Catholic High School serving the greater Easton, Pennsylvania and Phillipsburg, New Jersey area. The school is comprised of students from four surrounding Pennsylvania counties and two counties in New Jersey. It has a diverse socioeconomic background and varies in character from urban to suburban. The community is mostly residential with several commercial and light industrial areas.

Total enrollment for grades 9 through 12 is around 500 students. Courses are offered at college-prep, honors, and Advanced Placement levels. The Aquinas program provides academic support for students with learning differences. Vocational-technical opportunities are provided through the Career Institute of Technology and Bethlehem Area Vocational-Technical School. The school year is divided into two semesters of 18 weeks each, with nine-week quarterly reporting periods operating on an alternating (A/B day) schedule of four classes per day. Students are required to complete 20 hours of community service per school year.

The school is supervised by the Allentown Diocese Department of Education and is accredited by the Middle States Association and the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

COVID-19: For the 2020-2021 school year, students had the option to select either a hybrid in-person/virtual or a fully virtual instructional model. Students who selected the hybrid model had in-person instruction two days per week, and virtual instruction 3 days per week.

Notre Dame returned to full-time in-person instruction for the 2021-2022 school year.
