Internships/Shadow Programs

St. Luke's Shadowing Program with Scholarships

- Rising seniors eligible to apply
- *Personal Data Form (Application) to be completed, signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at Notre Dame
- Student should have an interest to pursue a career in healthcare, administration or business fields
- Student must complete a summer shadowing program (unpaid) of 50 hours
- Internship hours are arranged through hospital contact and scholarship is not applied to tuition account until hours are completed and evaluation is returned
- Applicant must submit two recommendations from NDHS faculty or staff (*Recommendation Form can be found on the ND website*)
- Applicant must submit a typed, one-page essay on the following subject: "How quality healthcare affects all aspects of the community it serves."
- For 2024-2025 award: Two (2) \$2,500 scholarships
- **Deadline**: Submit application & required supplements to Kelly Weber at kweber@ndcrusaders.org by March 30, 2024.

- Consideration will be given to character of the student, student as role model, variety of activities, school pride and teamwork
- Simple Tuitions Solution application necessary as financial need will be considered

- Students entering grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 are eligible
- *Personal Data form (Application) completed signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Student must have satisfactory discipline record at current school/Notre Dame
- List of extracurricular activities, employment (if applicable), leadership roles, honors/awards/recognitions
- Student must have interest in/passion for the arts, e.g. music, art, theater, etc. and include this in the list of activities.
- Simple Tuitions Solution application necessary as financial need will be considered
- Year 1 One page, typed essay on the following theme: "Why Notre Dame feels like 'home' to me".
- Year 2+ One page, typed essay on the following theme: "How Notre Dame continues to feels like 'home' to me" to be submitted each year by May 30 in order to remain eligible for subsequent years.

For 2024 - 2025 Award: Two (2) awards of \$2,500 for each year of his/her career at Notre Dame as long as eligibility requirements are met

- Proof of re-enrollment at Notre Dame HS for upcoming fall semester
- Student GPA of 2.5 or higher while at NDHS
- Student has a satisfactory discipline record
- List of extracurricular activities while at Notre Dame, including activities inside and outside of school and employment
- Student must provide two letters of recommendation from a teacher, coach, moderator or employer
- Student must have applied for and been awarded financial assistance through a Simple Tuitions Solution application at NDHS
- Student submits one essay (typed, double spaced, one page) titled: "Receiving an ND education is important to me and my family because....?"
- 2024-2025 Award: Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships payable to the student's NDHS tuition account

- Student has achieved a 2.0 GPA while at NDHS
- Student has a satisfactory disciplinary record while at NDHS
- List of all extracurricular activities while at NDHS, including activities inside and outside of school and employment
- Student must provide two letters of recommendation
- For 2024-2025 award: Two (2) \$1,500 awards credited to the higher education institution on behalf of the student

Timothy Grube Memorial Wrestling Scholarship - Graduating Senior Award

- Student must be a senior wrestler at Notre Dame High School during the 2023-2024 academic year
- *Personal Data form (Application) completed and signed by the Principal
- Minimum GPA of 2.00
- List of all extracurricular activities as well as honors/awards/recognitions
- List of all community activities involved with as well as any employment
- Student must be attending a 2 or 4-year college, university or trade school after graduation from ND
- One-page essay on the following subject: "What has wrestling taught me?"
- For 2024-2025 award: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior wrestler at the completion of his senior year. Award will be announced during the final home wrestling match. Student must provide proof of enrollment in a post-high school institution prior to award payment.
