MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

***Above the Best* – Patrick Mullins Class of 1964 Memorial Scholarship**

- Grades: Entering 10–12
- Minimum GPA: 2.5
- Essay: One-page typed essay that describes, *Describe when instance where you served someone and how it impacted you personally*
- Award: One (1) \$500. Announced at the Veteran’s Mass usually in November at NDHS.
- Deadline: **April 30, 2026**

Jeff Dailey Memorial Scholarship

- Grades: Entering 9–12
 - Minimum GPA: 3.0
 - Essay: One-page typed essay that describes, *What does the phrase “I am my brother’s keeper” mean to you?* In the essay, you must include examples of your actions that embody this statement.
 - Award: Eight (8) \$1,000.
 - Deadline: **April 30, 2026**

John Paul LeBec Memorial Scholarship for the Arts

- Grades: Entering 9–12
 - Minimum GPA: 3.0
 - Financial Need Considered
 - Students must have interest in/passion for the Arts, e.g. music, art, theatre, etc.
 - Essay Requirement:
 - **Year 1 (First-Time Applicants)**
Students applying for the scholarship for the first time — regardless of what grade they are in — must submit a one-page typed essay answering: “Why Notre Dame feels like home to me.”
 - **Year 2 + (Renewal Applicants)**
Students who have previously received the scholarship may re-apply each year to continue receiving it. For renewal applications, students must submit a one-page typed essay answering: “How Notre Dame continues to feel like home.”
 - Award: Two (2) \$2,500 renewable awards. Announced at the end of the year Awards Mass at NDHS.
 - Deadline: **April 30, 2026**

John Reichl Memorial Scholarship

- Grades: Entering 9–12
 - Financial Need Considered
 - Essay: One-page typed essay that describes, *My time at ND will help guide my life, both personally and professionally because...*
 - Award: Two (1) \$1,500
 - Deadline: **April 30, 2026**

O’Brien Family Memorial Scholarship

- Grades: Entering 10–12
- Minimum GPA: 2.5
- Essay (choose one): One-page typed essay that describes,
 - *Living in the moment is important because...*
 - *The arts are important to students today because...*
- Award: Two (2) \$250
- Deadline: **April 30, 2026**

ENDOWMENT & OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS

A.C.R.E. Scholarship

- Grades: Entering 10–12
- Minimum GPA: 2.5
- Essay: One-page typed essay that describes, *In what ways do you give back to Notre Dame High School community now, and how do you think your contributions are making ND a better place for students to thrive?*
- Award: One (1) \$1,000
- Deadline: **April 30, 2026**

Tuskes Family Scholarship Award – Incoming Freshmen

- Grade: Entering 9
- Partner Schools Only; St. Jane Frances de Chantal, Our Lady of Perpetual Help, St. Anne and Holy Family
- Financial Need Considered
- Proof of Registration at Notre Dame HS
- Letter of Recommendation: From the Principal
- Award: \$1,000
- 4-year Renewable Award, if student:
 - Maintains satisfactory academic (GPA of 2.0 or higher) and discipline records
 - Remains at Notre Dame HS
 - Continue to qualify for financial aid
- Deadline: **April 30, 2026**

Tuskes Family Scholarship Award – Returning Notre Dame Student

- Grades: 9–11
- Minimum GPA: 2.5
- Financial Need Considered
- Proof of Re-Enrollment Required
- Essay: One-page typed, double-spaced essay that describes, *Receiving a Notre Dame education is important to me and my family because...*
- Letter of Recommendations: Two letters from a teacher, coach, moderator or employer
- Award: Two (2) \$1,000
- Deadline: **April 30, 2026**

GRADUATING SENIOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Timothy Grube Memorial Wrestling Scholarship

- Eligible: Senior Wrestlers
- Maintains satisfactory academic (GPA of 2.0 or higher) and discipline records
- Two or four-year post-secondary enrollment required
- Essay: One-page typed essay that describes, *What wrestling has taught me*
- Award: One (1) \$1,000. Announced at the final home wrestling match and payment awarded at graduation
- Deadline: **November 1, 2026**

Tuskes Family Scholarship – Graduating Senior Award

- Maintains satisfactory academic (GPA of 2.0 or higher) and discipline records
- Two or four-year post-secondary enrollment required
- Award: Two (2) \$1,500
- Deadline: **April 30, 2026**
